



# Urgent Care vs Emergency Room

## Urgent Care

### Eye, Ear, Nose, Throat Conditions:

- Pink eye
- Earaches
- Sore throat
- Toothache
- Sinus symptoms

### Respiratory/Chest Complaints

- Simple cough

### Urinary Tract Complaints

- Uncomplicated bladder infection
- Uncomplicated sexually transmitted diseases

### Skin Complaints

- Simple rash
- Lice or scabies
- Simple lacerations
- Minor burns
- Simple abscesses

### Musculoskeletal Complaints

- Injury to wrist, hand, ankle, foot or digits without deformity

### Other Complaints/Problems

- Fever (infants and children >3 months old)
- Emergency contraception (uncomplicated)

## Emergency

### Eye, Ear, Nose, Throat Conditions:

- Foreign body in eye
- Nosebleed
- Sore throat with complication
- Dental trauma

### Respiratory/Chest Complaints

- Coughing up blood
- Chest pain
- Difficulty breathing

### Urinary Tract Complaints

- Kidney stones
- Sexually transmitted diseases w/complications

### Skin Complaints

- Hives with facial swelling
- Masses
- Complicated lacerations

### Musculoskeletal Complaints

- Pain or injury to: back, hip, leg, arm or knee

### Other Complaints/Problems

- Complicated fever
- Headache
- Abdominal pain
- Facial numbness
- Weakness
- Vomiting
- Blood in stool
- Anxiety/depression
- Post-op complications
