Urgent Care

Eye, Ear, Nose, Throat Conditions:

- · Pink eye
- Earaches
- Sore throat
- Toothache
- Sinus symptoms

Respiratory/Chest Complaints

Simple cough

Urinary Tract Complaints

- · Uncomplicated bladder infection
- Uncomplicated sexually transmitted diseases

Skin Complaints

- Simple rash
- Lice or scabies
- · Simple lacerations
- Minor burns
- · Simple abscesses

Musculoskeletal Complaints

 Injury to wrist, hand, ankle, foot or digits without deformity

Other Complaints/Problems

- Fever (infants and children >3 months old)
- Emergency contraception (uncomplicated)

Emergency

Eye, Ear, Nose, Throat Conditions:

- · Foreign body in eye
- Nosebleed
- Sore throat with complication
- Dental trauma

Respiratory/Chest Complaints

- · Coughing up blood
- · Chest pain
- · Difficulty breathing

Urinary Tract Complaints

- Kidney stones
- Sexually transmitted diseases w/complications

Skin Complaints

- Hives with facial swelling
- Masses
- Complicated lacerations

Musculoskeletal Complaints

· Pain or injury to: back, hip, leg, arm or knee

Other Complaints/Problems

- Complicated fever
- Headache
- Abdominal pain
- Facial numbness
- Weakness
- Vomiting
- Blood in stool
- Anxiety/depression
- Post-op complications
