

In 2023, we were able to gift over \$130,000 for the region's first hyperbaric oxygen (*HBO*) chamber in WinnMed's Wound Center (*pictured above*), and we were able to do that because of you! Your gifts stay right here to help grow and expand services locally.

Hyperbaric oxygen therapy involves breathing pure oxygen in a pressurized environment. This therapy is indicated for certain non-healing wounds, such as a diabetic foot ulcer, radiation injury or osteomyelitis. A hyperbaric oxygen chamber has been proven to enhance tissue oxygenation, stimulate growth factors, reduce inflammation, fight infection and ultimately promote healing.
